Current directions

- Aiming towards electronic accounting
 - Transactional documents: invoices, receipts
- Consumers are left outside the regulation
- For public sector buyers wide obligation to process EU Norm compliant electronic invoices
- Buyer organization right to require EU Norm compliant electronic invoices
- Under discussion:
 - Transition periods
 - Future roadmap
 - Frame agreement model

Practical achievements

- Both widely used local formats: TEAPPSXML and Finvoice have new versions for EU Norm compliance
- Technical documentation published in web for software developers and corporates
- Local formats cross-mapping published
- Current plan is to start supporting new versions in service provider and bank networks in November 2018
- Public sector contents instructions defined but not yet published

Co-operation with EU Norm defined syntaxes

- In short term
 - Expected that most organizations continue to use local formats in new versions
 - Service providers are demanded to execute required mappings between local formats and EU Norm syntaxes
- Future depends very much on defined roadmap and transition periods
